Sit

Christ's Suffering and Death Bring Division

Jeremiah 23:16–29 ~ Hebrews 11:17–31 (32–40); 12:1–3 ~ Luke 12:49–53 (54–56) The Lord Jesus causes fear and trembling and division because His Word is *"like fire … and like a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces"* (Jer. 23:29). His Law puts us all to death, whereas only His Gospel can bring us to life. He has fulfilled that Word for us by His cross and in His resurrection from the dead. He undergoes such a distressing baptism, accomplished by His death, in order to open the way for us through our Holy Baptism into His cross and resurrection. So, then, if we are able *"to interpret the appearance of earth and sky"* (Luke 12:56), let us mark this sign of His cross — recognizing that this world is subject to death, but knowing that Christ Jesus also has conquered death and obtained life everlasting for us. Let us fix our eyes on "Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith," and "run with endurance the race that is set before us" (Heb. 12:1–2).

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Jeremiah 23:16-29

The LORD of armies says: "Don't listen to what the prophets say. They give you empty hopes. They tell about visions of their own imagination that don't come from the LORD's mouth. They are telling those who despise Me, 'The LORD says: All will be well with you.' And they tell all who live in their own stubborn ways, 'No harm will come to you.' Who stands in the LORD's council and sees and hears what He says? Who pays attention and listens to what He says? Look! The LORD's storm! Fury has gone out, a tornado, whirling down on the heads of the wicked. The LORD will not stop being angry until He has finished, and carries out what He has planned. In the last days you will understand it clearly. I didn't send the prophets, and yet they ran. I didn't talk to them, and yet they prophesied. If they had stood in My council, then they would have told My people what I say and would turn them from the evil they live in and the evil they do. Am I a God who is only near and not far away?" asks the LORD. "Can anyone hide in a secret place so that I can't see him?" asks the LORD. "Don't I fill heaven and earth?" asks the LORD. "I've heard what the prophets say; those who tell lies in My name say, 'I had a dream, I had a dream!' How long will the hearts of these prophets tell lies and invent dishonest prophecies? By their dreams which they tell one another, do they plan to make My people forget My name, as their fathers forgot My name for Baal? If a prophet has a dream, let him tell it, but he who has My Word, let him faithfully speak My Word. Why mix the grain with the straw?" says the LORD. "Isn't My Word like fire?" says the LORD, "and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?"

EPISTLE LESSON

Hebrews 11:17-31(32-40), 12:1-3

By faith *Abraham*, when he was *tested*, *offered Isaac*. Yes, this man, who received the promises and was told: "Isaac's children will be called your descendants," was sacrificing his only son, thinking, "God can even raise him from the dead." And so, figuratively speaking, he did. By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau in regard to their future. By faith a dying Jacob blessed each of Joseph's sons and worshiped leaning on the top of his staff. By faith Joseph, when his end was near, remembered how the Israelites would leave Egypt and gave directions for his burial.

By faith, when Moses was born, his parents hid him three months because they saw he was a fine baby and they were not afraid of the king's order. By faith Moses,

when he grew up, refused to be called a son of Pharaoh's daughter and preferred being mistreated with God's people to enjoying the short-lived pleasures of sin. He considered the *abuse suffered for Christ* greater riches than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to the reward.

By faith he left Egypt without fearing the king's anger. He persisted as one who was constantly seeing Him Who can't be seen. By faith he celebrated the *Passover* and put the *blood* on the doorposts to keep him who *destroyed* the firstborn from touching his people. By faith they went through the Red Sea as if it were dry land. The Egyptians tried it, too, but were drowned. "By faith *the walls* of Jericho *fell* when the people marched around them seven days. By faith the prostitute Rahab welcomed the spies as friends and didn't perish with her disobedient people.

And what more should I say? There will not be time enough for me to tell about Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, David, Samuel, and the prophets, who by faith conquered kingdoms, did righteous works, received what was promised, *shut the mouths of lions*, put out raging fires, escaped death by the sword, found strength when weak, proved to be mighty in battle, put foreign armies to flight. Women received their dead back alive. Some were tortured; they refused to be freed, in order to rise to a better life.

Others suffered mocking and scourging and were even put in chains and in prison. They were stoned, tempted, sawed in half, murdered with a sword. They went around in sheepskins and goatskins, needy, oppressed, mistreated. The world wasn't worthy of them as they wandered around in deserts and in the hills, in caves and holes in the ground. By faith all these won approval but didn't receive what was promised. God provided something better for us in order to have them reach their goal with us.

Now then, with all these witnesses around us like a cloud, let us rid of every burden and the sin we easily fall into and with endurance run the race laid out before us, looking to Jesus, Who gives us our faith from start to finish. For the joy that was set before Him He endured the cross, thinking nothing of its shame, and *sat down at the right hand of God's throne.*

Think of how sinners opposed Him and He endured it. It will help you not to get tired and give up.


