Jesus Christ Is the Great Shepherd of His Sheep

Ezekiel 34:11–24 ~ 1 Timothy 1:(5–11) 12–17 ~ Luke 15:1–10

"The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" (1 Tim. 1:15). As He had mercy on Paul, in order to "display his perfect patience" (1 Tim. 1:16), so also does He seek out His sheep "from all places where they have been scattered on a day of clouds and thick darkness" (Ezek. 34:12). To deliver His flock, He "will seek the lost, ... bring back the strayed, ... bind up the injured, and ... strengthen the weak" (Ezek. 34:16), and "they shall no longer be a prey" (Ezek. 34:22). He sets over them one great Good Shepherd, the Son of David, who "shall feed them and be their shepherd" (Ezek. 34:23). For Christ Jesus is the one man who, "having a hundred sheep, if he has lost one of them," would "leave the ninety-nine in the open country, and go after the one that is lost, until he finds it" (Luke 15:4). When He finds the lost one and brings it home rejoicing, "the angels of God" and all the company of heaven rejoice with Him, with great joy (Luke 15:7, 10).

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Ezekiel 34:11-24

"The Lord GOD says this: Look! I, even I, will search for My sheep and look after them. As a shepherd looks after his flock when they are scattered around him, so I will take care of My flock and rescue them from every place where they may be scattered on cloudy and gloomy days. I will bring them away from those peoples, gather them from those countries, bring them to their own land. I will feed them on the hills of Israel, by the streams, and in all the places of that land where it is so good to live. I will feed them in good pasture, and their grazing land shall be on the high mountains of Israel. There they will rest in a good place and graze in a rich pasture on the mountains of Israel. I will feed My sheep and let them rest, says the Lord GOD. I will look for the lost, bring back what was driven away, bandage broken limbs and strengthen the sick, but I will destroy the fat and strong ones feeding them with justice. "And as for you, My sheep, the Lord GOD says this: I will judge between sheep and sheep, between rams and male goats. Is it not enough for you to feed on the best pasture? Must you trample with your feet on the rest of the pasture? You drink clear water. Must you make what is left muddy with your feet? So My sheep have to eat what your feet have trampled on and drink what your feet have made muddy. So the Lord GOD says this: Look! I, even I, will judge between the fat and the lean sheep. You with your sides and shoulders push away all the weak animals and gore them with your horns until you have scattered them far and wide. Therefore I will rescue My flock so that they will no more be a prey, and I will judge between one sheep and another. "I will raise up one Shepherd over them, My Servant David, Who will feed them. He will feed them and be their Shepherd. I the LORD will be their God, and My Servant David will be the Ruler among them. I the LORD say so.

EPISTLE LESSON

1 Timothy 1:(5–11) 12–17

The goal of our instruction is love flowing from a pure heart, from a good conscience, and from a sincere faith. Certain people have failed to find this and have turned to silly talk. They want to be teachers of the Law but don't understand what they say or the things they so confidently express. But we know the Law is good if it is used as it was meant to be used, if we keep in mind that the Law is not meant for a righteous man but for those who break the Law and rebel against it, the ungodly and sinners, those who live unholy lives and insult holy things, those who kill their fathers or mothers, murderers, men who sin sexually with women or with other men, kidnappers, those who lie or swear to lies – and anything else that is contrary to sound teaching. This is

according to the good news of the glory of God, the Blessed, that was entrusted to me. I thank Christ Jesus, our Lord, whose power has been in me. He thought I could be trusted and appointed me to do His work although I used to slander, persecute, and shamefully mistreat Him. But He was merciful to me because, when I didn't believe, I didn't know what I was doing. Our Lord poured His grace on me, bringing faith and love in Christ Jesus. This is a statement that can be trusted and deserves complete acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. I am the worst of them, but God was merciful to me so that Jesus Christ would first show in me all His longsuffering and make me an example to those who are going to believe in Him and live forever. To the everlasting King, the immortal, invisible, and only God, be honor and glory forever. Amen.
