The Son of God Has Set Us Free from Sin and Death by His Grace Revelation 14:6-7 ~ Romans 3:19-28 ~ John 8:31-36

"Wisdom is justified by her deeds" (Matt. 11:19), and the true Wisdom of God, Christ Jesus, the incarnate Son, justifies us by His deeds. He prepares His way by the preaching of repentance, but He has suffered the violence of the Law and voluntarily handed Himself over to violent men, that we might eat and drink with Him in His Kingdom and "remain in the house forever" (John 8:35). For He is "a

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friend of tax collectors and sinners" (Matt. 11:19), and He has rescued us by His grace from the slavery of sin and death. By the proclamation of His eternal Gospel "to those who dwell on earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people" (Rev. 14:6), "the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law" (Rom. 3:21), "that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus" (Rom. 3:26). And by hearing the Gospel of Christ Jesus, "whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith" (Rom. 3:25), "you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free" (John 8:32).

EPISTLE LESSON

Romans 3:19-28

Now we know that whatever the Law says, it says to those who are under the Law, so that every mouth may be silenced and the whole world may stand guilty before God. Therefore *not one person will be declared righteous before God* by doing what the Law says, because the Law teaches us to recognize sin. But now God has shown His righteousness apart from the Law. The Law and the prophets tell about it. This righteousness through faith in Jesus Christ comes from God to all who believe. There is no difference. All have sinned and come short of God's glory. They are declared righteous freely by His grace through the ransom Christ Jesus paid to free them. God publicly set Him up to be the *Atonement Cover* through faith in His blood, to show His righteousness even though He had patiently passed by the sins done in the past. Now He wanted to show His righteousness, to be righteous Himself and to declare righteous anyone who believes in Jesus. What then becomes of our pride? It is excluded. How? By the way of works? No, by the way of faith. We are convinced that anyone is declared righteous through faith without the works of the Law.

Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed in Him, "If you live in My Word, you are truly My disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will free you." We are Abraham's descendants," they answered Him, "and have never been anyone's slaves.

How can you say, 'You'll be freed'?" I tell you the truth," Jesus answered them, "everyone who lives in sin is a slave to sin. A slave doesn't stay in the home forever. A son stays forever. If the Son frees you, you will really be free."



And, ironically enough, Luther said this should make him the "apostle of works" because once we are freed by grace, we are truly free to serve God in works that flow from thankfulness and praise.
