God's Plan of Redemption Trumps Earthly Destruction and Violence Malachi 4:1–6 ~ 2 Thessalonians 3:(1–5) 6–13 ~ Luke 21:5–28 (29–36)

There are signs of the Lord's coming all around: the cross that marks His Church, the violence and death of the sinful world, and the shaking of the natural order. *"There will be great distress upon the earth"* (Luke 21:23), but the faithful know that *"the kingdom of God is near"* (Luke 21:31). Therefore, *"straighten up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near"* (Luke 21:28). Be awake and alert, and heed the words of Christ, which *"will not pass away"* (Luke 21:33). For you, *"the sun of righteousness shall rise with healing in its wings"* (Mal. 4:2). He sends His preachers of repentance in the spirit and power of Elijah *"before the great and awesome day of the LORD comes"* (Mal. 4:5), in order to *"direct your hearts to the love of God and to the steadfastness of Christ"* (2 Thess. 3:5).

Although you are often faithless, *"the Lord is faithful,"* and by the preaching of His Word *"he will establish you and guard you against the evil one"* (2 Thess. 3:3). Therefore, *"do not grow weary in doing good"* (2 Thess. 3:13). In the midst of calamity, believe upon the Lord, Jesus Christ.

There will be great earthquakes and famines and plagues in different places, terrible sights and great signs coming from heaven. Before all these things happen, men will arrest you and persecute you, hand you over to church councils, and put you in prisons. They'll bring you before kings and governors on account of My name. It will be your chance to tell them the truth. So make up your minds not to worry beforehand how you'll defend yourselves. I'll give you such speech and wisdom none of your enemies will be able to oppose it or talk against it. Even parents, brothers, relatives, and friends will betray you and kill some of you, and everyone will hate you because of My name. But not a hair on your head will be lost. Endure patiently, and you'll win your lives. When you see Jerusalem surrounded by an army, then know the time has come for her to be destroyed. Then if you're in Judea, flee to the hills. If you're in Jerusalem, leave it. If you're in the country, don't go into the city. Those will be days of vengeance when everything must happen as it is written. "Woe to the women who in those days are expecting babies or nursing them. There will be great distress in this country, and God will punish this nation. The sword will cut them down, they'll be taken away as prisoners among all nations, and the Gentiles will trample on Jerusalem until the time for the Gentiles has passed. There will be signs in the sun, the moon, and the stars, and on the earth nations will be in distress, not knowing which way to turn from the roaring and tossing of the sea. People will faint as they fearfully wait for what will happen to the world. The powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. When these things begin to happen, stand ready and look forward cheerfully because you will soon be set free." Then He pictured it this way: "Look at a fig tree, or any of the trees. As soon as leaves grow on it, you see and know without being told that summer is near. So also when you see those things happen, you know God's kingdom is near. I tell you the truth: these people will not pass away until everything happens. Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away. "Be careful never to get your hearts burdened with drunkenness and its nausea and with worries about this life, or that day will take you by surprise like *a trap*. It will surprise all people wherever they *live on the earth*. But always watch and pray to be considered worthy to escape all these things that are going to happen and to stand before the Son of Man."
