





OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Jeremiah 25:15-38

The LORD, the God of Israel, says this to me: "Take from My hand this wine cup of My fury and make all the nations to whom I'm sending you drink it: When they drink it, they will stagger and go mad, due to the sword I'm sending among them."

I took the cup from the LORD's hand and made all the nations to whom the LORD sent me drink it: Jerusalem and Judah's towns, its kings and leaders, to make them a desolation and a ruin, something shuddered over, scorned, and cursed, as it is today. And these will also drink: Pharaoh, king of Egypt, his men, leaders, and all his people, and all the foreigners among them, all the kings of the land of Uz, and all the kings of the country of the Philistines (Ashkelon, Gaza, Ekron, and those who were left in Ashdod), Edom, Moab, the people of Ammon, and all the kings of Tyre and all the kings of Sidon, and the kings on the coasts on the other side of the sea, Dedan, Tema, Buz, and all who clip their hair at the temples, all the kings of the Arabs, and all the kings of the mixed people living in the wilderness, and all the kings of Zimri, all the kings of Elam, all the kings of the Medes, and all the kings of the north, living near and far from one another, and all the kingdoms of the world that are on the earth, and last of all the king of Sheshak will drink.

"You shall tell them: 'The LORD of armies, the God of Israel, says: Drink and get drunk; vomit, fall, and don't get up because of the sword I'm sending among you.' If they refuse to take the cup from your hand to drink it, tell them, 'The LORD) of armies says: You must certainly drink it.'

If I start by bringing disaster On the city named after Me, , should you go unpunished? You will not go unpunished! I'm calling for a sword to come on all the people in the world, says the LORD of armies.'

Prophesy to them all these things and tell them: 'The LORD roars from on high and calls from His holy mansion.

He roars against His fold.

He shouts like those trampling grapes against all the people living in the world.

A noise is sounding to the ends of the earth because the LORD accuses the nations.

He is out to judge all people.

He will give the wicked to the sword.' "

This is the Word of the LORD.

The LORD of armies says:

"See, disaster is spreading from nation to nation and a great storm is stirring from the distant places of the earth."

On that day those whom the LORD will kill will be from one end of the earth to the other. They will not be mourned, taken away, and buried, but will be like manure on the ground.

Howl, shepherds, and cry. Leaders of the flock, roll on the ground - the time has come for you to be slaughtered. I will scatter you, and you will fall like a precious vessel. There will be no way for the shepherds to flee, no escape for the leaders of the flock. Listen to the shepherds crying and the leaders of the flock wailing because the LORD is plundering their pasture. The peaceful pastures are destroyed by the LORD's blazing anger. Like a lion He has left His lair - their country is turned to ruins by His violent sword and blazing anger.

NEW TESTAMENT LESSON

Revelation 14:6-13

I saw another angel flying high in midair with everlasting good news to tell those living on the earth, every *nation*, *tribe*, *language*, and *people*. "Fear God and give Him glory," he called out with a loud voice; "the time has come for Him to judge. And worship Him Who made heaven, the earth, the sea, and springs of water."

A second angel followed him. "She has fallen!" he said. "The great Babylon has fallen — she who made all the nations drink of the wine of her immoral passion." A third angel followed them. "If anyone worships the beast and his statue," he called out with a loud voice, "and is branded on his forehead or on his hand, he must also drink of the wine of God's anger, poured out unmixed into the cup of His punishment, and must be tortured by fire and sulfur before the holy angels and before the Lamb. The smoke of their torture

goes up forever. There's no rest day and night for those who worship the beast and his statue and for anyone branded with his name." Here the holy people need to stand their ground as they keep on observing what God has commanded and trusting in Jesus. Then I heard someone say from heaven: "Write, blessed are the dead who die in the Lord!" "Certainly, says the Spirit,, "let them rest from their hard work; what they have done goes along with them."







The congregation's response may begin just as the leader's petition ends so that the word "Lord" is sung simultaneously by both leader and congregation.




Luther's Evening Prayer


