The Word of the Gospel Opens the Eyes of Faith and Fixes Them on Christ Jesus Genesis 12:1–9 ~ Romans 4:1–8, 13–17 ~ John 3:1–17

The Lord called Abram (Abraham) to leave his home and go to a land that God would show him. He also promised to make of Abram "a great nation," to bless him and make his name great as a blessing to "all the families of the earth" (Gen. 12:2–3). "Abram went, as the LORD had told him" (Gen. 12:4), and in Canaan "he built an altar to the LORD and called upon the name of the LORD" (Gen. 12:8). He "believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness" (Rom. 4:3). Here the grace of God is manifested, that He "justifies the ungodly" (Rom. 4:5), not by works of the Law, but through faith in His promises. He removes all of our sins and lawless deeds through Jesus Christ, the offspring of Abraham in whom all the Lord's promises are realized. This forgiveness of sins is the Word of the Gospel, the voice of the Holy Spirit, which "gives life to the dead" (Rom. 4:17). It opens the eyes of faith to behold Christ Jesus, the Son of Man lifted up on the cross, "that whoever believes in him may have eternal life" (John 3:14–15).

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Genesis 12:1-9

The LORD said to Abram, "Leave your land, your relatives, and your father's home, and go to a land I will show you. I will make you a great nation. I will bless you and give you a great name, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and curse anyone who curses you, and in you all the peoples on the earth will be blessed." Abram went as the LORD told him, and Lot went with him. Abram was 75 when he left Haran. Abram took his wife Sarai, his brother's son Lot, all the property they had gotten and the persons they had added in Haran, and they left to go to the land of Canaan. When they came to Canaan, Abram traveled through the country to the place at Shechem, as far as the oak of Moreh. The Canaanities were then in the country. The LORD appeared to Abram. "I'm going to give this land to your descendants," He said. Abram built an altar for the LORD, Who had appeared to him. Then he moved away to the hills of east Bethel, and he put up his tent there with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east. There he built an altar to the LORD and preached in the LORD's name. Again he moved, and he kept on moving toward the South

EPISTLE LESSON

Romans 4:1-8, 13-17

What should we say Abraham, our natural ancestor, found? If he was declared righteous by what he did, he had something to boast about. But he couldn't boast before God. What does the Bible say? "Abraham believed God and so he

was counted righteous." If you work, your pay isn't considered a gift but a debt. But if instead of working you believe in Him Who declares the ungodly righteous, your faith is counted as righteousness. So David calls the man blessed whom God counts righteous apart from what he does: "Blessed are you if your wrongs are forgiven and your sins are covered. Blessed are you if the Lord doesn't count sins against you."

It was not by the Law that Abraham or his descendants received the promise that he would inherit the world, but it was by the righteousness of faith. For if the Law is the way to inherit, then faith has been made worthless and the promise has been made powerless. No, the Law brings God's anger on us, and only where there is no Law there is no breaking of the Law. Therefore the promise is by faith that it might come to us by grace, so that the promise might be sure to all the descendants, not only to those who live by the Law but also to those who only believe as Abraham did. He is the father of all of us, as it is written: *"I have made you a father of many nations."* Standing before. God, Abraham believed God makes the dead live and calls into being that which doesn't exist.

Nicodemus asked Him. "You are the teacher in Israel," Jesus said to him, "and don't know this? I tell you the truth, We tell what We know, and We testify to what We have seen. But you people don't accept Our testimony. If you don't believe the earthly things I told you, how will you believe Me if I tell you heavenly things? No one has gone up to heaven except the One Who came down from heaven - the Son of Man. As Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up so that everyone who believes in Him has everlasting life. God so loved the world that He gave His only-begotten Son so that whoever believes in Him would not perish but have everlasting life. You see, God didn't send His Son into the world to condemn the world but to save the world through Him.


