

Hope Lutheran Chapel Communion Statement: If you are a confirmed member in good standing of a LCMS or an AALC congregation, are repentant of your sins, and believe Jesus gives you His true body and blood for the forgiveness of your sins in the Lord's Supper, you are welcome

to commune with us today. (I Cor. 11:17-32) For Lutherans, receiving the Lord's Supper, is an action of the celebrating community, signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. (I Cor. 10:14-22, 11:18-19, 26; Eph. 4:2-6) If you are a visitor from another Christian Church body or other faith, we welcome you to our service. As a sad consequence of the divisions in Christianity we cannot extend to you a general invitation to the Lord's Supper. Reception of the Lord's Supper by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray. If you are a visitor and not sure whether or not you should commune, please speak with the Pastor, Elder, or Usher before the service.

Communion Note: For those who need assistance with the cup please hold out your hand and the Elder will hand it to you. *Please place cup in buckets at end of rail when finished*.



Christ Jesus Breathes His Spirit and His Life into Us by the Ministry of the Gospel Acts 5:29–42 ~ 1 Peter 1:3–9 ~ John 20:19–31

The crucified and risen Lord Jesus establishes the ministry of the Gospel in order to bestow His lifegiving Holy Spirit and His peace upon the Church. To those who are called and ordained to this office, and to those they serve in His name, He grants the Holy Absolution of all sins. By the fruits of His cross, He replaces fear and doubt with peace and joy, and thus gives *"repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins"* (Acts 5:31). Through the preaching of His sent ones, He calls us to believe that He *"is the Christ, the Son of God,"* so that by such faith we *"may have life in his name"* (John 20:31). In His resurrection, we have the *"living hope"* to which we have been *"born again"* and by which we are guarded *"for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time"* (1 Peter 1:3, 5). Until then, *"though you have not seen him, you love him,"* and by the mercies of God *"you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory"* (1 Peter 1:8).

FIRST LESSON

Acts 5:29-42

Peter and the other apostles answered, "We must obey God rather than men You hanged Jesus on a cross and murdered Him. But the God of our fathers raised Him and took Him up to His right hand as Leader and Savior in order to give the people of Israel repentance and forgiveness of sins. We are witnesses of these things - we and the Holy Spirit, Whom God has given those who obey Him." "When they heard this, they became furious and wanted to kill them. But a Pharisee in the court by the name of Gamaliel, a teacher of the Law, highly respected by all the people, got up and ordered the men taken outside for a little while. "Men of Israel," he said to them, "consider carefully what you're going to do with these men. Sometime ago Theudas appeared, claiming to be somebody, and about four hundred men joined him. He was killed, and all who followed him were scattered, and they disappeared. After him, at the time of the census, came Judas from Galilee and got people to follow him in a revolt. He perished, too, and all who followed him were scattered. And now I tell you, keep away from these men and let them alone. If it's only men planning or doing this, it will break down, but if it's God, you won't be able to stop them. You may even be fighting against God." They took his advice. They called the apostles, beat them, ordered them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go. The apostles left the court, happy to have been thought worthy to suffer shame for Jesus. And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they kept right on teaching and telling the good news that Jesus is the Christ.

EPISTLE LESSON

Let us praise the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who by raising Jesus Christ from the dead has in His great mercy given us a new birth so that we have a living hope for an inheritance that isn't destroyed or defiled and never fades way, as it is kept for you in heaven. And through faith you are protected by God's power until you come to the salvation that is waiting to be revealed at the end of time. This delights you, although now for a little while you may have had to suffer various trials. Gold is tested by fire, and your faith, when it is tested, should be found to be much more precious than gold, which perishes. This is how you will have praise and glory and honor when Jesus Christ appears again. You never saw Him, but you love Him. You don't see Him now, but you believe in Him. And a joy, unspeakable and wonderful, fills you with delight as you receive by faith what you're looking for your - salvation.

John 20:19-31

P The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the twentieth chapter.

Glory to You, O Lord. (sing)

That Sunday evening the doors were locked where the disciples were, because they were afraid of the Jews. Then Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace to you!" When He said this, He showed them His hands and His side. Then the disciples were delighted to see the Lord. "Peace to you!" Jesus said to them again. "As the Father sent Me, so I send you." When He had said this, He breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whenever you forgive people's sins, they are forgiven; whenever you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven." But Thomas, one of the twelve, who was called Twin, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We saw the Lord." "Unless I see the marks of the nails in His hands,"

he told them, "and put my finger in the marks of the nails and put my hand in His side, I won't believe it." A week later His disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. The doors were locked, but Jesus came and stood among them. "Peace to you!" He said. Then He told Thomas, "Put your finger here, and look at My hands and take your hand and put it in My side. And don't doubt but believe." "My Lord and my God!" Thomas answered Him. "Do you believe because you've seen Me?" Jesus asked him. "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." His disciples saw Jesus do many other miracles that are not written in this book. But these things are written so that you believe Jesus is the Christ, God's Son, and by believing have life in His name.


