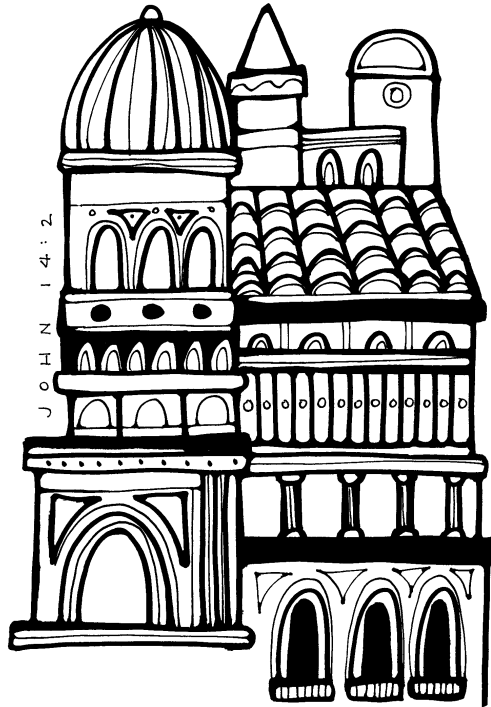

Hope Lutheran Chapel Communion Statement: If you are a confirmed member in good standing of a LCMS or an AALC congregation, are repentant of your sins, and believe Jesus gives you His true body and blood for the forgiveness of your sins in the Lord's Supper, you are welcome to commune with us today. (I Cor. 11:17-32) For Lutherans, receiving the Lord's Supper, is an action of the celebrating community, signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. (I Cor. 10:14-22, 11:18-19, 26; Eph. 4:2-6) If you are a visitor from another Christian Church body or other faith, we welcome you to our service. As a sad consequence of the divisions in Christianity we cannot extend to you a general invitation to the Lord's Supper. Reception of the Lord's Supper by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray. If you are a visitor and not sure whether or not you should commune, please speak with the Pastor, Elder, or Usher before the service.

Communion Note: For those who need assistance with the cup please hold out your hand and the Elder will hand it to you. Please place cup in buckets at end of rail when finished.

The Lord Jesus Christ Is the Way, the Truth and the Life

Acts 6:1–9; 7:2a, 51–60 ~ 1 Peter 2:2–10 ~ John 14:1–14

The risen Lord Jesus alone is *“the way, and the truth, and the life,”* and we come *“to the Father”* only through Him (John 14:6). God is thus *“glorified in the Son,”* and those who believe in Him will do the works of Christ because He goes to the Father for us (John 14:12–14). Stephen, *“a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit”* (Acts 6:5) and *“doing great wonders and signs among the people”* (Acts 6:8), did the works of Christ. When he was falsely accused and put to death, he *“gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God”* (Acts 7:55). Fixing his hope there, he commended his spirit to the Lord Jesus and prayed for his murderers. In the same way, all the baptized are called to follow the example of Christ Jesus by faith. Though He was *“rejected by men”* in the sight of God, He is *“chosen and precious”* (1 Peter 2:4). He is the chief cornerstone of the Father’s *“spiritual house,”* and we are built upon Him as *“living stones”* (1 Peter 2:5).

FIRST LESSON

Acts 6:1-9; 7:2a, 51-60

In those days, as the number of the disciples grew larger and larger, a complaint was brought against those who spoke Aramaic by those who spoke Greek that every day, when the food was handed out, their widows were being neglected. The twelve called the whole group of disciples together and said, “No one likes it if we give up teaching God's Word and serve at tables. Now, fellow disciples, appoint seven men among you whom people speak well of, who are full of the Spirit and wisdom and we'll put them in charge of this work. Then we'll devote ourselves to praying and to serving by speaking the Word.” The whole group liked the idea. So they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolaus (who had become a Jew in Antioch). They had these men stand before the apostles, who prayed and laid their hands on them. God's Word kept on spreading, and the number of disciples in Jerusalem was getting very large. Even a large crowd of the priests came to believe and obey the Word. Stephen, full of God's gifts and power, was doing great wonders and miracles among the people. Some men of the Synagogue of the Freedmen, as it was called, and of men from Cyrene and Alexandria, and men from Cilicia and Asia got up to argue with Stephen.

He answered, *“How stubborn you are and pagan at heart and deaf to the truth! You're always opposing the Holy Spirit. Your fathers did it, and so do you! Was there ever a prophet your fathers didn't persecute? They killed those who announced, 'The Righteous One will come!' and now you betrayed and murdered Him. Angels were ordered to give you the Law, but you didn't keep it!”* While they were listening, the men of the council became furious and ground their teeth at him. But he, full of the

Holy Spirit, gazed up to heaven and saw God's glory and Jesus standing at God's right hand. "Look!" he said, "I see heaven opened and the Son of Man standing at God's right hand." But they yelled at the top of their voices, held their ears shut, and all together rushed at him. They threw him out of the city and started to stone him. The witnesses had laid their outer clothes at the feet of a young man - his name was Saul. While they were stoning Stephen, he called, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." Then, kneeling, he called out loud, "Lord, don't hold this sin against them." When he had said this, he fell asleep.

EPISTLE LESSON

1 Peter 2:2-10

And like newborn babies, thirst for the pure milk of the Word so that you'll grow and finally be saved. *Surely you have tasted that the Lord is good.* Come to Him. He is the living *Stone* Whom men rejected but God *selected* as precious. You also are being built as living stones into a spiritual temple, to be holy priests who bring spiritual sacrifices that God gladly accepts through Jesus Christ. The Bible says: *"I am laying in Zion a Cornerstone, chosen and precious, and if you believe in Him, you'll never be disappointed."* He is *precious* to you who believe, but to those who do not believe *"He is the Stone which, rejected by the builders, has become the Cornerstone, the Stone they stumble over and the Rock they fall over."* When they disobey the Word, they stumble over it; that's the end appointed for them. But you are a *chosen people, priests of the King, a holy nation, a people saved to be His own and to tell of the wonderful deeds* of Him Who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. Once you were *not a people*, but now you are *God's people*. Once you had *received no mercy*, but now you have *received mercy*.

John 14:1-14

You know the way to the place where I'm going.” “Lord, we don't know where You're going,” Thomas said to Him. “So how can we know the way?”

“I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life,” Jesus answered him. “No one comes to the Father except by Me. If you have learned to know Me, you'll know My Father, too. From now on you know Him and have seen Him.” Philip said to Him, “Lord, show us the Father; that's enough for us.” “I've been with all of you so long,” Jesus answered him, “and you don't know Me, Philip? If you have seen Me, you have seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father?' Don't you believe I am in the Father and the Father is in Me? What I tell you doesn't come from Me, but the Father, Who lives in Me, is doing His works. Believe Me, I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me. Or else believe Me because of My works.

“I tell you the truth, if you believe in Me, you'll do the works I'm doing, and you'll do greater works than these, because I'm going to the Father, and I will do anything you ask in My name in order that the Son may glorify the Father. If you ask Me for anything in My name, I'll do it.
