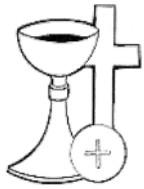

Hope Lutheran Chapel Communion Statement: If you are a confirmed member in good standing of a LCMS or an AALC congregation, are repentant of your sins, and believe Jesus gives you His true body and blood for the forgiveness of your sins in the Lord's Supper, you are welcome to commune with us today. (I Cor. 11:17-32) For Lutherans, receiving the Lord's Supper, is an action of the celebrating community, signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. (I Cor. 10:14-22, 11:18-19, 26; Eph. 4:2-6) If you are a visitor from another Christian Church body or other faith, we welcome you to our service. As a sad consequence of the divisions in Christianity we cannot extend to you a general invitation to the Lord's Supper. Reception of the Lord's Supper by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray. If you are a visitor and not sure whether or not you should commune, please speak with the Pastor, Elder, or Usher before the service.

Delivered from Sin and Death, You Now Live before God in the Righteousness of Christ

Jeremiah 20:7–13 ~ Romans 6:12–23 ~ Matthew 10:5a, 21–33

The outcome of sin is death, *“but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord”* (Rom. 6:23). He has set you free from the slavery of sin and has brought you *“from death to life”* (Rom. 6:13). No longer are you under the condemnation of the Law, but you live *“under grace”* (Rom. 6:14). Such is your courage in the face of *“those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul”* (Matt. 10:28). For though *“you will be hated by all”* and maligned by the world for the name of Christ (Matt. 10:22, 25), you abide in the care of your Father in heaven, who numbers *“even the hairs of your head”* and values you more *“than many sparrows”* (Matt. 10:30–31). By the Word of Christ, you have become like Him, your Teacher and Master in whom you endure to the end, and *“will be saved”* (Matt. 10:22, 25). For He is with you *“as a dread warrior,”* who has overcome your enemies (Jer. 20:11). By the righteousness of faith, He delivers your heart, mind, body and life *“from the hand of evildoers,”* and He brings you into the land of the living (Jer. 20:12–13).

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON*Jeremiah 20:7-13*

LORD, You have misled me and I let You mislead me. You grabbed me and conquered me. I've been a joke all day long. Everyone mocks me. Whenever I talk I have to cry out, calling, *“Violence and destruction!”* Speaking the Word of the LORD has brought me only disgrace and mockery all day long. When I think I will not mention Him and say no more in His name, then His Word is in my heart like a burning fire, shut up in my bones. I try hard to hold it in but in vain — I can't do it. I hear many whispering, on every side terrifying me, *“Denounce him! We'll denounce him!”* All my friends are watching to see me make a false move, saying, *“Perhaps he will be misled; then we'll take him and avenge ourselves on him.”*

But the LORD is with me like a terrifying warrior. That is why those who pursue me will fall and can't win. They will fail badly because they don't act wisely. Their everlasting shame will not be forgotten. O LORD of armies, You test the righteous and *search their inmost thoughts* — I want to see You take vengeance on them because I've laid my case before You. Sing to the LORD. Praise the LORD because He saves the life of the needy from the hands of the wicked.

EPISTLE LESSON*Romans 6:12-23*

Then sin should no longer rule in your dying bodies and make you do what they wish. Don't let sin keep on using the parts of your body as tools for doing wrong. But as

people who have come back from the dead and live, give yourselves to God, and let God use the parts of your body as tools for doing what is right. Sin will never rule over you, because you are not under the Law but under grace.

What then? Are we going to sin because we are not under the Law but under grace? Certainly not! Don't you know if you give yourselves to anyone to obey him as slaves, you are his slaves? Either you are the slaves of sin and will die, or you obey God resulting in righteousness. But thank God! Although you once were the slaves of sin, you have heartily obeyed the pattern of teaching to which you were entrusted. Freed from sin, you were made the slaves of righteousness. I talk in a human way because you are naturally weak. But just as you once let uncleanness and wickedness use the parts of your body as slaves to do wrong, so now let righteousness use the parts of your body as slaves in order to live holy. When you were slaves of sin, you weren't free to serve righteousness as your master. What was your advantage then in doing the things that make you blush now? For they end in death. But now that you've been made free from sin and have been made slaves of God, your advantage is that you live in a holy way and finally have everlasting life. The wages paid by sin is death, but the gift given freely by God in Christ Jesus our Lord is everlasting life.

HOLY GOSPEL LESSON

Matthew 10:5a, 21-33

P The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, the tenth chapter.

Everyone will hate you because of My name. But be faithful to the end, and you will be saved. When they hunt you in one town, flee to another. I tell you the truth, before you have gone through all the towns of Israel, the Son of Man will come."

"A pupil isn't above his teacher, nor a slave above his master. A pupil should be satisfied to share his teacher's lot and a slave to share his master's. If the master of the

house was called Beelzebul, how much more certainly the members of his household! So, don't be afraid of them.”

“All that's covered will be uncovered, and all that's hidden will be known. What I say to you in the dark, tell in the daylight; and what you hear whispered in your ear, preach from the housetops. Don't be afraid of those who kill the body and can't kill the soul, but *fear Him* who can destroy soul and body in hell. Aren't two sparrows sold for a cent? And not one of them will fall to the ground without your Father's permission. As for you, even the hairs on your head are all counted. So don't be afraid. You're worth more than many sparrows. Whoever will confess Me before other people, him will I confess before My Father in heaven. Whoever will deny Me before others, him will I deny before My Father in heaven.”

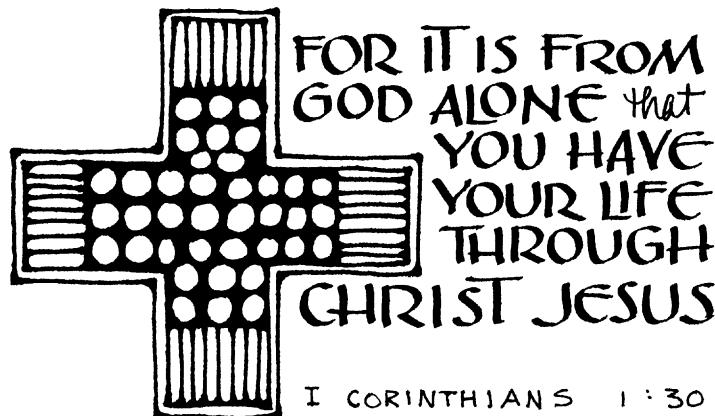
