(I Cor. 11:17-32) For Lutherans, receiving the Lord's Supper, is an action of the celebrating community, signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. (I Cor. 10:14-22, 11:18-19, 26; Eph. 4:2-6) If you are a visitor from another Christian Church body or other faith, we welcome you to our service. As a sad consequence of the divisions in Christianity we cannot extend to you a general invitation to the Lord's Supper. Reception of the Lord's Supper by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray. God's Gift of Forgiveness Engenders Our Forgiveness of Others

Zephaniah 1:7–16 ~ 1 Thessalonians 5:1–11 ~ Matthew 25:14–30

The Day of the Lord is “*near and hastening fast,*” and it will be “*a day of distress and anguish, a day of ruin and devastation*” (Zeph. 1:14, 15). The Lord will search out and punish “*the men who are complacent*” concerning His Word, “*who fill their master’s house with violence and fraud*” (Zeph. 1:9, 12). Then all their works and efforts will be for nothing: “*Though they build houses, they shall not inhabit them; though they plant vineyards, they shall not drink wine from them*” (Zeph. 1:13). But those who fear, love and trust in the Lord are “*good and faithful*” stewards of His property (Matt. 25:21). They live by faith in His free gift of forgiveness, and they multiply His goods in the loving forgiveness of their neighbor, and “*the master of those servants*” settles His accounts with them by the gracious reckoning of His Gospel (Matt. 25:19). Likewise, “*God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ*” (1 Thess. 5:9). Therefore, let us also “*put on the breastplate of faith and love*” in our dealings with one another (1 Thess. 5:8).

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON*Zephaniah 1:7-16*

“Be silent before the Lord GOD, because the day of the LORD is near, and the LORD has prepared a sacrifice. He has invited guests and consecrated them. On the day of the LORD's sacrifice I will punish the officials and the king's sons and all who dress in foreign clothing. On that day I will punish all who jump over the threshold to fill their masters' palace with crime and cheating. On that day,” says the LORD, “a cry will come from the Fish Gate and a wailing from the second part of the city, and a loud crash will echo from the hills. Weep, you who live in the Mortar, because all the merchants will be wiped out and all who weigh out silver will be destroyed. At that time I will search Jerusalem with lamps and punish the men who are settled in their complacency thinking that the LORD doesn't do anything good or bad. Their wealth will be taken as plunder, and their homes turned to ruins. They will build houses, but they won't live in them. They will plant vineyards, but they won't drink any wine from them.”

“*The LORD's great day is near. It is near and coming very quickly. Listen! The sound of the day of the LORD will be bitter, the shriek of the warrior will be horrible. That day will be a day of wrath, a day of trouble and anguish, a day of wreck and ruin, a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and thick darkness, a day of trumpet blowing and battle cries against the fortified towns and the corner towers.*”

EPISTLE LESSON*1 Thessalonians 5:1-11*

You don't need anyone to write and tell you exactly when things will happen, my fellow Christians, because you know very well the Lord's day will come just like a thief in the night. When people say, “All's well and safe!” then destruction will come on them suddenly like labor pains on a woman who is going to have a baby, and they will not escape. But you, my fellow Christians, are not in the dark that you should let that day take you by surprise like a thief. You are all the children of light and of the day.

We have nothing to do with night and darkness. Let us not sleep, then, like the others, but be awake and sober. People sleep at night and get drunk at night. But let us who live in the daylight be sober and *put on* faith and love *as a breastplate* and the sure hope of *salvation as a helmet*. God didn't appoint us to be punished by His anger but to be saved by our Lord Jesus Christ. Who died for us so that, awake or asleep, we may live with Him. Then encourage one another and strengthen one another just as you are doing.

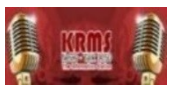
