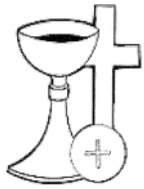

Hope Lutheran Chapel Communion Statement: If you are a confirmed member in good standing of a LCMS or an AALC congregation, are repentant of your sins, and believe Jesus gives you His true body and blood for the forgiveness of your sins in the Lord's Supper, you are welcome to commune with us today. (I Cor. 11:17-32) For Lutherans, receiving the Lord's Supper, is an action of the celebrating community, signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. (I Cor. 10:14-22, 11:18-19, 26; Eph. 4:2-6) If you are a visitor from another Christian Church body or other faith, we welcome you to our service. As a sad consequence of the divisions in Christianity we cannot extend to you a general invitation to the Lord's Supper. Reception of the Lord's Supper by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray. If you are a visitor and not sure whether or not you should commune, please speak with the Pastor, Elder, or Usher before the service.

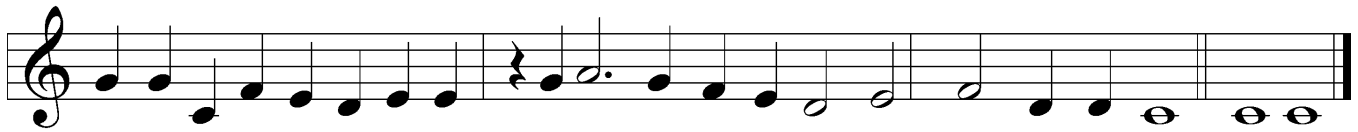

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Micah 3:5-12

The LORD says this against the prophets who lead my people astray: “When they have something to bite with their teeth, they preach, 'All is well!' But they declare war against the man who doesn't put anything in their mouths. That is the reason night will come on you, and you won't have a vision, a darkness in which you won't be able to tell the future. The sun will go down on the prophets, and the day will turn black over them. The seers will be disgraced and the diviners ashamed. 1 Thessalonians 4:1-12

And now, my fellow Christians, this is what we ask and urge you to do in the Lord Jesus. You learned from us how you are to live and please God, and that is how you

are living. But now do so more and more. You know what instructions we gave you by the Lord Jesus. God wants you to be holy and keep away from sexual sin. Every one of you should know how to get a wife in a holy and honorable way and not in the way of passionate lust *like the people of the world who don't know God*. No one should wrong and cheat his fellow Christian in business, because *the Lord avenges* all these things, as we told you and warned you before. God didn't call us to be unclean, but holy. Now, if anyone rejects this, he doesn't reject a man but God, *Who gives you His Holy Spirit*.

You don't need anyone to write you about brotherly love, because God has taught you to love one another, and you are practicing it toward all the Christians all over Macedonia. But we urge you, my fellow Christians, grow more and more, do your best to live quietly, mind your own business, and work with your hands, as we ordered you to do, so that you live nobly with those who are not Christians—without needing anything.

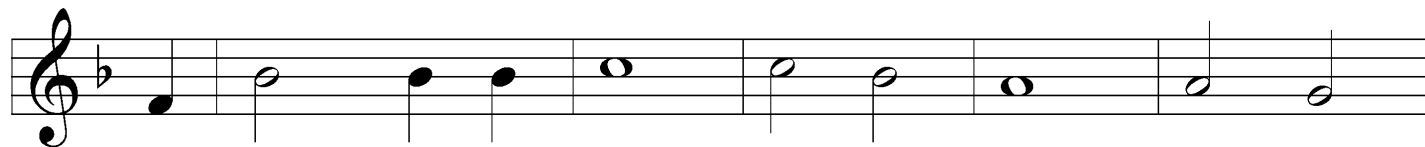
