OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Ezekiel 37:1-14

The LORD laid His hand on me and by His Spirit took me out and put me down in the middle of a valley that was full of bones. He led me past them all around. EPISTLE LESSONActs 2:1-21

The day of Pentecost came, and they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like a violent blast of wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw tongues like flames that separated, and one rested on each of them. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and started to speak in other languages as the Spirit gave them the ability to speak.

Jews who feared God had come from every nation under heaven to live in Jerusalem. When that sound came, the crowd gathered and was dumbfounded because each one heard the disciples speak his own language. Amazed and wondering, they asked,

"Don't all these who are speaking come from Galilee?
