God the Father sent His Son into the world, so that the world might have life in Him. Now He "draws" you to His Son, Christ Jesus, by the preaching of His Gospel. "Everyone who has heard and learned from the Father" comes to Jesus, who will never cast him out but "will raise him up on the last day" (John 6:44–45). He is "the bread of life," who "comes down from heaven" in the flesh, that you may eat of Him and "live forever" (John 6:48–51). Although "the journey is too great for you," in the strength of this food you shall come to "the mount of God." Do not be afraid, and do not despair, but "arise and eat" (1 Kings 19:5–8). And "no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds" (Eph. 4:17), but "walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us" (Eph. 5:2). In Him, you have been "created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness" (Eph. 4:24). Therefore, "be imitators of God, as beloved children" (Eph. 5:1), by "forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you" (Eph. 4:32).

#### **OLD TESTAMENT LESSON**

1 Kings 19:1-8

Ahab told Jezebel everything Elijah had done and especially how he killed all the prophets with the sword. Then Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah. "May the gods punish me again and again," she said, "if by this time tomorrow I don't do to you what

you did to them." Frightened, Elijah fled to save his life and came to Beer-sheba, which belonged to Judah, and he left his servant there. Then he traveled for a day into the wilderness, sat under a broom tree, and wished he were dead. "I've had enough now, LORD." he said. "Take my life - I'm no better than my fathers." He lay down under a broom tree and slept. Then an angel came and touched him. "Get up and eat," he told him. When he looked, he saw near his head some bread baked on hot stones and a jar of water. So he ate and drank and lay down again. The angel came back again and touched him. "Get up and eat," he told him, "or your journey will be too much for you." He got up, ate, and drank. Strengthened by that food, he went on for 40 days and nights till he came to Horeb, the mountain of God.

#### EPISTLE LESSON

Ephesians 4:17-5:2

So I tell you and call on you in the Lord not to live any more like the people of the world. Their minds are set on worthless things. Their understanding is darkened. Their ignorance and their closed minds have made them strangers to the life God gives. Having lost their sense of right and wrong, they've given themselves up to a life of lust to practice every kind of vice with greed. But that is not what you learned when you got to know Christ, if you have heard Him and in Him have been taught the truth as it is in Jesus. Strip off your old self, which follows your former ways of living and ruins you as it follows the desires that deceive you. Become new in the spirit of your minds, and put on the new self, which is created to be like God, righteous and holy in the truth. So don't lie any more, but tell one another the truth, because we are members of one another. Be angry but don't sin. Don't let the sun go down on your anger. Don't give the devil a chance to work. Anyone who has been stealing should not steal any more, but instead work hard, doing something good with his own hands so that he has something to share with anyone in need. Don't say anything harmful but only what is good, so that you help where there's a need and benefit those who hear it. And don't grieve God's Holy Spirit, by Whom you were sealed for the day when you will be set free. Get rid of all bitter feelings, temper, anger, yelling, slander, and every way of hurting one another. Be kind to one another and tenderhearted, and forgive one another as God in Christ has forgiven you. As God's dear children try to be like Him and live in love as Christ loved us and gave Himself for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.


