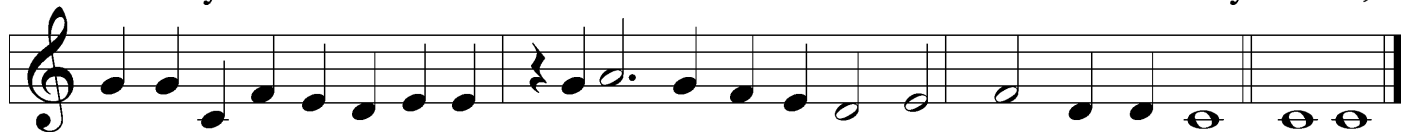

### *Saints Are Blessed in the Eternal Presence of Christ*

*Revelation 7:(2-8) 9-17 ~ 1 John 3:1-3 ~ Matthew 5:1-12*

“A great multitude ... from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages,” cry out, “Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne” (Rev. 7:9-17). Faith-filled saints from every place and time, with unified voices, eternally magnify the Lamb of God. As His beloved children, we, too, “shall see him as he is” (1 John 3:1-3). Joined with the throng of angels and myriad saints, we shall “serve him day and night in his temple” (Rev. 7:9-17). In our earthly tension vacillating between saint and sinner, faith and doubt, sacred and profane, we earnestly seek Jesus to calm our fears, comfort our spirits and forgive our sins. The Holy Spirit through faith in Christ propels us forward, fortifying us in Word and Sacrament, to our eternal home. In the midst of our constant struggle as believers, we need to be blessed. And so we are. The poor in spirit, the meek, the hungry, the thirsty, the merciful, the pure and the persecuted are all blessed, and we will most certainly inherit the kingdom of heaven (Matt. 5:1-12).

Then I saw another angel coming up from the east with the seal of the living God, and he called out loud to the four angels who had been given power to damage land and sea. “Don't damage land, sea, or trees,” he said, “until we have put the *seal on the foreheads* of the servants of our God.” And I heard the number of those who were sealed: “144,000.” They were from every tribe of the people of Israel. There were sealed:

- 12,000 from the tribe of Judah,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Reuben,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Gad,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Asher,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Naphtali,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Manasseh,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Simeon,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Levi,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Issachar,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Zebulun,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Joseph,
- 12,000 from the tribe of Benjamin.

After that I saw a large crowd that no one could count, from every *nation, tribe, people, and language* standing before the throne and before the Lamb, wearing white robes, with palms in their hands. And they called out loud: “We are saved by our *God Who sits on the throne* and by the Lamb!” All the angels stood around the throne, around the elders and *the four living beings*, and *bowed down* before the throne, with their faces to the ground, *worshiped God*, and said: “Amen! Praise, glory, wisdom, thanks, honor, power, strength be to our God forever! Amen.” Then one of the elders turned to me and asked, “These people dressed in white robes - who are they and where did they come from?” And I answered him, “Sir, you know.” Then he told me, “They are the people who have come through great suffering, who have *washed their robes* and made them white in *the blood of the Lamb*. That is why they are before the throne of God and serve Him day and night in His temple, and *He Who sits on the throne will spread His tent over them. They will never be hungry or thirsty again, and the sun or any heat will never burn them*, because the *Lamb before the throne will be their Shepherd*, and *He will lead them to springs of the water of life*. And *God will wipe every tear from their eyes.*”
