

(I Cor. 11:17-32) For Lutherans, receiving the Lord's Supper, is an action of the celebrating community, signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. (I Cor. 10:14-22, 11:18-19, 26; Eph. 4:2-6) If you are a visitor from another Christian Church body or other faith, we welcome you to our service. As a sad consequence of the divisions in Christianity we cannot extend to you a general invitation to the Lord's Supper. Reception of the Lord's Supper by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray. If you are a visitor and not sure whether or not you should commune, please speak with the Pastor, Elder, or Usher before the service.

Communion Note: For those who need assistance with the cup please hold out your hand and the Elder will hand it to you.

If it is difficult for you to kneel at the rail, please feel free to remain standing.





EPISTLE LESSON


1 John 4:7-16

Dear friends, let us love one another because love comes from God and everyone who loves is God's child and knows God. He who doesn't love hasn't learned to know God, because God is Love. This is love, not that we loved God but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the payment for our sins. Dear friends, if that's how God loved us, then we should love one another. And the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures and ascended into heaven


